DURHAM OUTLOOK \$15,000



Durham Outlook for the Needy is a non-profit organization established in 1990 by local residents. Durham Outlook's core program is St. Vincent Pallotti's Kitchen - Durham Region's only seven-day-a-week, 365-day-a-year soup kitchen. With the leadership of more than 1200 volunteers per month, St. Vincent Pallotti's Kitchen serves an average of 150 people per day who are experiencing poverty and food insecurity. Annually, it serves an average of 50,000 meals per year.

Since 1990, they have served 1.3 million meals.

Currently they are focusing on a campaign to help build, from the ground up, a new, 100% accessible facility. The funding will help them build the new facility.

INTENDED OUTCOME

Durham Outlook hopes to continue to serve the needs of the community by continuing to offer the low cost, nutritious meal. But also plan on using the funds to support the construction of a new, 100% accessible facility to serve meals in, and to store food. They anticipate a 30% increase in patronage at the new location and know that they will be able serve a wider community once they have an accessible facility.
