360°KIDS \$120,000



Funds raised from the Hockey Helps the Homeless York Region tournament supports the Transitions program at 360°kids. The Transitions program is a voluntary transition to independent living program for youth 17-26. Furnished rental apartments are secured throughout York Region by 360°kids to provide affordable housing options in a graduated market-rent program for youth to allow them to be able to continue to work or go to school while subsidized rent allows them to work towards paying market rent in their apartment. In addition, a Case Worker is assigned to every youth to work with them one-on-one and assist them with goal setting and achievement, problem solving, and access to additional community supports including educational and employment supports in order to live independently.

Located in the Village of Markham Heritage Conservation District, 17 Mill Street is a home that has gone into a state of disrepair but is now being renovated by 360°Kids. Participants in their Transitions program would apply to reside in this program for a longer term from the help of funds raised through the Hockey Helps the Homeless York Region Tournament.
