DAVID BUSBY STREET CENTRE \$54,000



Funds raised from the HHTH 2018 Tournament will be used to continue and expand operations, and enhance our community Drop-In Centre programming to include emergency group lodging. Their drop-in support centre is the core of their support and served over 2,200 unique individuals and families in 2017 who are experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness.

INTENDED OUTCOME

By supporting the two organizations from the Hockey Helps the Homeless Barrie tournament, you too are partners on this very important project that will assist in creating safe, supportive, warm and welcoming space for each residents new home. It will improve participants general health, broaden access to housing, connect people to appropriate services, shorten the path from homelessness to housing, and improve access to low barrier shelters.

REDWOOD PARK COMMUNITIES \$54,000



Thanks to you, funds will be used for 3 programs/projects including Redwood Rent Supplement Program, which will provide rent support for the most vulnerable families, the Family Support Team, which will off-set the cost of community events to encourage social interaction as well as personal care packages, and lastly, New Housing, which will off-set costs of creating new housing units for the most vulnerable in our community.

INTENDED OUTCOME

The outcome we achieve is individuals, families and children who because of having safe, secure, hopeful, supported housing, are able to heal from emotional and physical trauma and/or addictions, and to secure sustainable education and employment.

HOME FOR GOOD MOTEL CONVERSION PROJECT



The David Busby Street Centre and Redwood Park Communities have partnered with the County of Simcoe in the Home for Good Motel Conversion Project to convert a Barrie motel into 12 bachelor apartments, 5 second-stage recovery units, and a community space for individuals experiencing chronic homelessness. It will provide stable and supportive housing with the conversion of Barr's Motel Property and face off against the affordable housing crisis in Barrie.
