Danny was asked to leave his family home at the young age of 14. "When I got kicked out, I didn't know where I'd end up or what I'd be doing," he said. After two years without a fixed address, staying where he could and couch-surfing, Danny was finally connected with Youth Opportunities Unlimited (YOU) in London.

This past year, Danny also participated in the Hockey Helps the Homeless tournament and played on a winning team. "I'm looking forward to having a jersey with my name on it. I think that's going to be pretty cool," Apacik said.
