

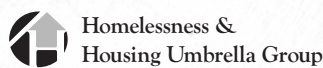


YOUR IMPACT IN 2017 KITCHENER-WATERLOO

HHUG \$42,000



Your contributions will support the core work of Homelessness and Housing Umbrella Group (HHUG) which includes offering low cost training to staff and volunteers of agencies and groups working in the housing stability sector, working with all orders of government to create public policy which supports ending homelessness and the creation of affordable housing, information sharing and networking within the sector and the general public.

INTENDED OUTCOME

Because of the Homeless and Housing Umbrella Group's support, information, and training, the Kitchener-Waterloo area will be better informed and have a skilled housing stability sector with improved public policies.

LUTHERWOOD \$42,000



Funds will support Lutherwood's Safe Haven Shelter which is a 10 bed shelter for vulnerable youth between the ages of 12 and 18. HHTH will ensure that Lutherwood is able to maintain staffing to support youth accessing services including life and social skills programming. At the shelter, youth are provided with their basic needs, and a discharge/housing plan which may include reintegration into their family unit, independent living, or supportive housing options.

INTENDED OUTCOME

Last year, stats from Lutherwood stated that 95.5% of their youth returned home or to a safe living environment which prevented them from returning or going to the street. This year, they aspire to be at a 100%.

HOUSE OF FRIENDSHIP \$42,000



Your donation to House of Friendship will support the Charles Street Men's Shelter which focuses on getting men into permanent housing. HHTH will fund the hiring of a Program Resource Worker (PRW) who meets with the men who enter the Shelter and develops an individualized, permanent housing search plan and provides a one-to-one connection with a customized level of support based on the individual's needs and requirements.

INTENDED OUTCOME

All the men who enter the shelter will be welcomed by a caring and professional Program Resource Worker who will listen to their story. They will receive both practical and emotional support to help change their life.

ONEROOF YOUTH SERVICES \$42,000



Thanks to you, oneRoof Youth Services operates a youth specific (ages 16-25) shelter with 17 co-ed shelter beds, providing for the safety, security, and well-being of the most vulnerable population. Not only do they provide beds, but also live skills development, basic necessities, intensive care management, crisis management, family mediation, support, advocacy, and goal setting.

INTENDED OUTCOME

To continue the operation of the shelter and provide the necessary supports to the over 300 unique youth they serve a year.

YW KITCHENER-WATERLOO \$42,000



With your help, the YW Emergency Shelter will continue to operate their 66-bed shelter for homeless women and families. They provide basic necessities, crisis support, and housing help to approximately 350 adults and 150 children and youth each year.

INTENDED OUTCOME

The funding will allow the YW Emergency shelter to provides 635 nights of basic needs, crisis support and housing help to women, children and families that are homeless.
